

SODIT BURSARY

Applications are invited for the annual Society of Devon Intensive Therapists (SODIT) bursary

The SODIT bursary is open to trainee doctors, nurses, AHPs and Advanced Practitioners working in 2017 in Cornwall, Devon and Somerset.

It is anticipated that the successful project will be some form of participation/observation or research into a clinical practice which could be transferable and potentially beneficial to critically ill patients in the South West.

The maximum value of the award is £1000, the actual amount awarded will be judged on the predicted costs but will not necessarily cover the entire cost.

To apply, send a brief (max 500 words) outline of your intended project to michaelspivey@nhs.net including:

- The theory and/or current evidence behind the clinical practice/research
- Practical means by which it could be applied to critically ill patients in the South West
- Approximate cost of undertaking your project (funding time off, travel, accommodation, equipment etc)

We anticipate that the successful applicants will present their work at a future SODIT meeting
